Recommendations

1. Use only UTP (unshielded cable)
2. If they already have the facility wired with STP/FTP cables they need to use an adapter (unshielded coupler)* either on the switch side or AP’s side that converts STP/FTP to UTP

**Any standard off-the-shelf unshielded coupler will apply*
