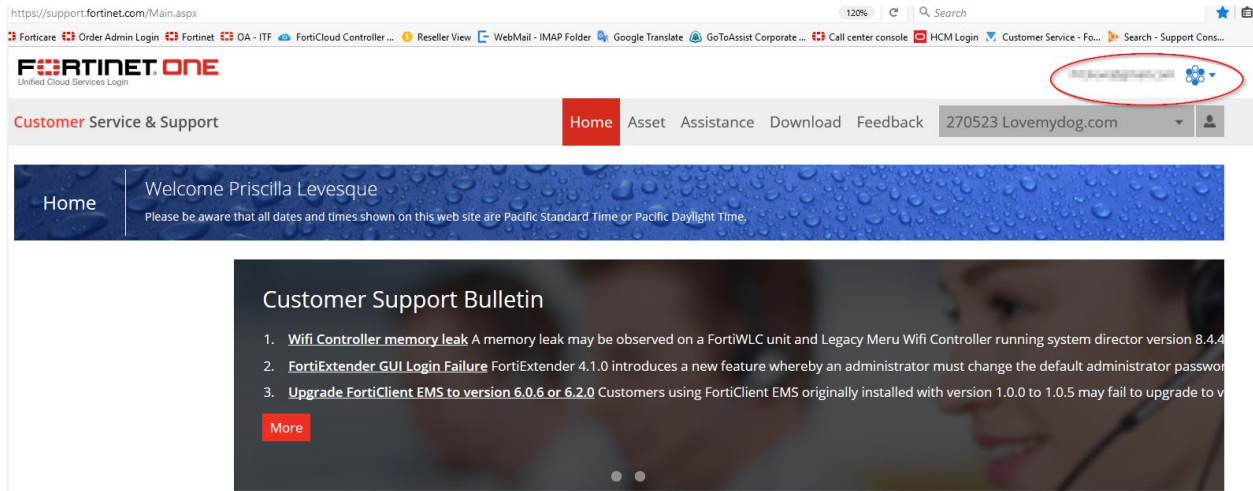


## To Enable Two-Factor Authentication in the FortinetOne Portal

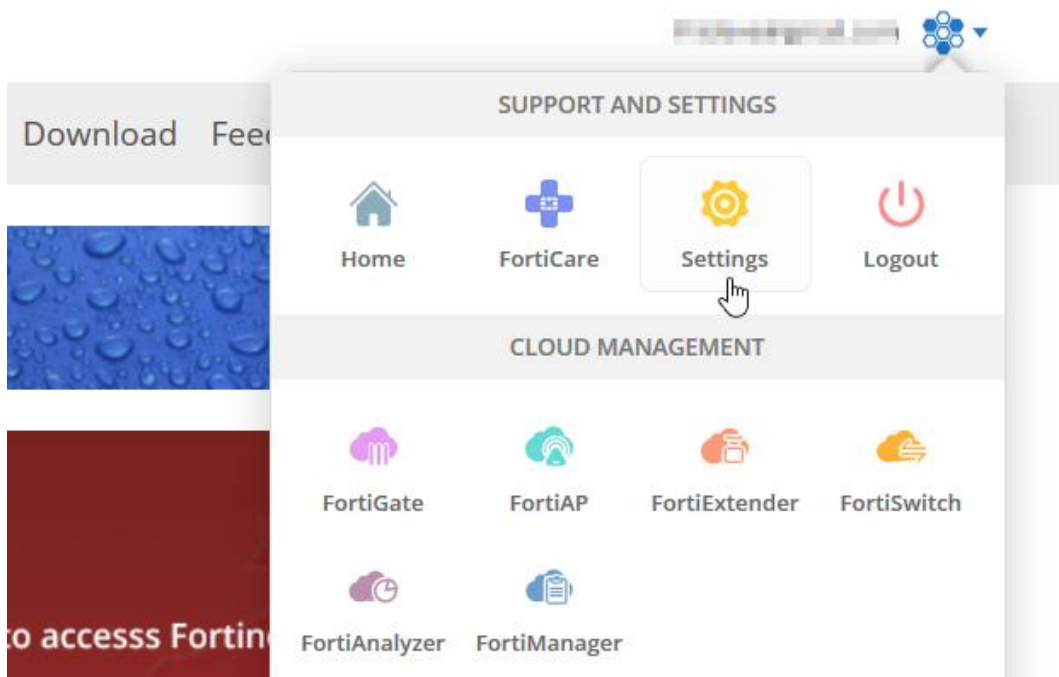
To Enable Two Factor Authentication from with the FortinetOne portal ([www.support.fortinet.com](http://www.support.fortinet.com))
